School Uniform Reminder

Smart black school shoes	Smart Black school shoes

Children should not wear trainers in to school (even black ones) and should not wear boots. In winter weather children can wear boots in to school, but we will expect them to change into smart school shoes.

PE Kit

Every child must have a PE kit in school which contains, blue shorts, white T-shirt, black plimsolls and optional trainers. For the winter months a plain tracksuit may be worn for outside PE.

Earrings
